

Nova Scotia Honour Jazz: 2024-2025 Report

Enrollment: 34 students registered for this season, not including members of the NSHJ Funk Unit (explanation below). 25 attended the first session in Truro, and 31 attended the second session in Dartmouth. Our third and final session will be on March 28-30th in Antigonish.

NSHJ Funk Unit: 8 members of the Funk Unit attended the first weekend. However, later in the fall they decided to no longer participate in the NSHJ weekends. This was understandable as most are now college age and busy with other things. Two Funk Unit members still wished to attend and were placed in a newly created Funk Combo along with some members taken from other ensembles.
